Under 18 years old person - a written parent's or legal guardian's consent to take part in the tournament (according to an enclosed form). A competitor without the consent is automatically excluded from kumite competition.

One person from each team is obliged to referee during matches and to wear a full referee's garment required by IKO standards. As the tournament will be carried on three mats, additional referees are welcome.

4. Competition:

The tournament will be carried in following competitions **kumite** categories (Fighting according to IKO regulations):

• kumite semi contact - under 18 years old competitors







- kumite full contact for seniors (but with the use of shin and foot protectors)
- ADULT MEN (+18 YEARS OLD)
- ADULT WOMEN (+18 YEARS OLD)
- MASTERS (+35 YEARS OLD)
- ADULT MEN FIRST STEP (+18 YEARS OLD)
- ADULT WOMEN FIRST STEP (+18 YEARS OLD)
- MASTERS FIRST STEP (+35 YEARS OLD)

There will be 2 rounds in following competitions kumite categories (by age and gender):

- o I round obligatory the kata will be determined by the judge's decision,
- o II round the competitor performs any of the kata listed below:
- Adults
 - I. round: Geksai-sho
 - II. round: Kanku-dai,, Seienchin, Sushi-ho, Garyu, Seipai.
- Boys and girls 16-17 years old | Boys and girls 14-15 years old
 - I. round: Tsuki no kata
 - II. round: Pinian sono go, Gekisai sono ichi,, Yantsu, Saifa. Gekisai sono san
- Boys and girls 12-13 years old
 - I. round: Pinian sono san.
 - II. round: Pinian sono yon, Tsuki no kata, Geksai sono ichi, Geksai sono san, Yantsu, Saifa
- Boys and girls 10-11 years old
 - I. round: Pinian sono ichi
 - II. round: Pinian sono ni, Pinian sono yon, Pinian sono san, Tsuki no kata, Geksai sono ichi, Geksai sono san







Competitors will be divided into groups **based on the date of birth!** The Administrator reserves a right to make changes to weight categories, please declare an exact weight with accuracy up to 1 kg.

 -55 kg; -60 kg; -65 kg; -70kg; -75kg; over 75 kg,
- 14 15 years old
 -45 kg; -50 kg, -55 kg, -60 kg, -65 kg, -70 kg, over 70 kg
- 12 13 years old
 -40 kg, -45 kg, -55 kg, 60 kg, +60 kg
- 10 11 years old
 -30 kg, -35 kg, -40 kg, -45 kg, over 45 kg
- 8 9 years old
 -25 kg, -30 kg, -35 kg, over 35 kg
- 6 7 years old
 -25 kg, -30 kg, over 30 kg

Girls:

- 16 17 years old
 -55 kg, -60 kg, over 60 kg
- 14 15 years old
 -50 kg, -55 kg, over 55 kg
- 12 13 years old
 -45 kg, -50 kg, over 50 kg
- 10 11 years old
 -30 kg, -35 kg, -40 kg +40 kg
- 8 9 years old
 -25 kg, -30 kg, over 30 kg
- 6 7 years old-20 kg, -25 kg, over 25 kg







RULES OF SEMI CONTACT KUMITE COMPETITION

The tournament will be played individually in a Cup's System. One category may be combined with another one by the decision of Main Referee if there are fewer than three competitors. Competitors of all age categories will be fighting according to world-wide IKO regulations.

Competitors should wear protectors as follows:

- white shin&instep protectors,
- white hand protectors,
- boys groin protector,
- headgear with face cage,
- hogo (6-13 years old),
- girls breast protector, separate plates (foamed) and elastic/stretchy top,
- soft knee guards.

Competitor is required to be ready to fight after call out in no longer than 1 minute time in full set of protectors. The Administrator do not provide obligatory protectors.

Fight time:

• 6-11 years old:

1 min round -> play-off time 1 min -> weight (more than 3 kg difference is decisive) -> second play-off time 1 min, after which the verdict must be reached.

• 12-17 years old:

2 min round -> play-off time 2 min -> weight (more than 3 kg difference is decisive) -> second play-off time 2 min, after which the verdict must be reached.







KUMITE ADULTS

Competitors who in the day of the tournament are 18 years old yet but not more than 35 years old. The administrator reserves the right to change the weight categories.

KUMITE FULL CONTACT

- ADULT MEN (18-35 years old)
 -60kg, -70 kg, -80 kg, -90 kg, over 90 kg
- ADULT WOMEN (+18 years old)
 -55kg, -65 kg, over 65 kg
- MASTERS (+35 years old)
 -85 kg, over 85 kg

ADULTS FIRST STEP

(18-35 years old) up to 5th kyu who did not win a medal in a national competition (National Championships, National Cup etc.) division into weight categories after applications.

(over 35 years old) people up to 5th kyu who did not win a medal in a national competition (National Championships, National Cup etc.) division into weight categories after applications.

RULES OF FULL CONTACT KUMITE COMPETITION

The tournament will be played individually in a Cup's System. One category may be combined with another one by the decision of Main Referee if there are fewer than three competitors. Competitors of all age categories will be fighting according to world-wide IKO regulations.

Competitors should wear protectors as follows:

- white shin&instep protectors,







- mouth/teeth guard

29th January 2022

- men groin protector,
- women breast protector, separate plates (foamed) and elastic/stretchy top
- soft knee guards,

If a competitor fights without a teeth protector, he does so at his own risk. In the event of an illegal punch to the head, which, in the opinion of the judges, should not lead to disqualification of the competitor, if there is an injury or damage to the teeth which, according to the doctor, makes it impossible to continue the fight, the fouled person may lose the fight.

Competitor is required to be ready to fight after call out in no longer than 1 minute time in full set of protectors. The Administrator do not provide obligatory protectors.

Fight time

adults

2 min round -> play-off time 2 min

Finals: 3 min round -> play-off time 2 min -> weight -> 2 min

• adults first step and masters

1,5 min round -> play-off time 1.5 min

In case of a small number of participants, the categories will be combined.

5. Participation fee:

Competitors pay 60 PLN or 15 € as a participation fee. This should be paid in cash on the day of the tournament.

6. Awards and teams ranking:

For the first, second and third places in all categories, the competitors will receive cups and diplomas. Teams scoring rules:

1st place - 5 points, 2nd place - 3 points, 3rd place - 1 points.







7. Registration:

29th January 2022

- a) Registration of fighters will be taken through osusoftware.com web page. The registration will end on 20th of January at midnight. There will be no possibility to add competitor after that date.
- a) Registration of fighters will be taken through osusoftware.com from 27th December to 20th January 2022 (Tuesday) 24:00;
- b) A list of competitors will be available on 27th January at www.next.osusoftware.com . If anyone sees any mistake on the list, please send email immediately to contact@osusoftware.com or a text message to senpai Natalia Stachowicz, mobile number number +48 579 729 146;
- c) Checkup of all documents such as medical certificate from a sports doctor, ID card, IKO Membership Card, waiver of claims against the organizer, a written parent's or legal guardian's consent to take part in the tournament will take place during the verifications.

Competitors who do not have current medical examinations/certificates (sports doctor) and other required documents will be excluded from the starting list.

This does not exempt the club from paying the starting fee!

The competitors will be verified only after the payment.

Verification of competitors arriving on Friday will take place from 7 pm (in dojo Wrocław ul. Legnicka 65).

8. Schedule for the Saturday, 29th January:

- 08:00 10:00 am Verification at the sports hall,
- 10:00 am Consultations of heads of teams
- 11:00 am kata (in the case of a faster kata end, the elimination fights in kumite will begin),
- 1:00 pm Official opening,
- 1:30 pm kumite (all categories),
- about 6:00 pm Official end of the tournament
