# 4. Registration and Check-In

  - Location: Tokei Martial Arts and Fitness Centre, 28 Magdalen St, London SE1 2EN (a
    5-minute walk from London Bridge Station and a 1-minute walk to Tower Bridge).
- Required Documents: At check-in, all participants must present a valid passport or ID, IKO membership card, proof of insurance, a medical certificate, and signed waiver forms.

#### 5. Fees

Spectators: Free entry.

Kata OR Kumite: £40 or €45 Kata AND Kumite: £70 or €75

Payment: Can be made at check-in or via bank transfer by contacting the organiser.







# 6. Rules & Regulations

- Tournament Rules: The event will follow official IKO international Kata and Kumite rules.
- **Uniform (Dogi)**: The Dogi must only have the kanji on the left chest. No other symbols are permitted.
- Coaches: Teams are limited to one coach for every four competitors.
- Categories: Some categories may be combined or removed if there is a lack of competitors.

# 7. Protection Requirements

Head guards and body protectors will be provided. Fighters may use their own personal gear if it is approved by the organiser during check-in.

Category	Required Protections
Boys (8-15)	Headgear (with face cover), body protector, fist guards, shin/instep pads, groin cup, knee protection.
Girls (8-15)	Headgear (with face cover), body protector, fist guards, shin/instep pads, girls' groin guard, knee protection.
Boys (16-17)	Headgear (no face cover), fist guards, shin/instep pads, groin cup, knee protection. (Mouthguard optional).
Girls (16-17)	Headgear (no face cover), breast pads, fist guards, shin/instep pads, girls' groin guard, knee protection. (Mouthguard optional).
Men (+18)	Groin cup. (Mouthguard optional).
Women (+18)	Breast pads, women's groin guard. (Mouthguard optional).
Senior Men (+40)	Headgear (no face cover), fist guards, shin/instep pads, groin cup, knee protection. (Mouthguard optional).
Senior Women (+35)	Headgear (no face cover), fist guards, shin/instep pads, women's groin guard, knee protection. (Mouthguard optional).

- o Girls Kumite: -30kg, -35kg, +35kg
- **Duration**: Elimination: 90s. Final: 90s > 90s.
- o Kata: Round 1 (Taikyoku Sono San), Final (Pinan Sono Ichi).

#### • 10 - 11 Years Old

- Boys Kumite: -40kg, -45kg, +45kg
- o Girls Kumite: -35kg, -40kg, +40kg
- O **Duration**: Elimination: 90s. Final: 90s > 90s.
- Kata: Round 1 (Pinan Sono Ni), Final (Pinan Sono San).

#### • 12 - 13 Years Old

- Boys Kumite: -45kg, -50kg, +50kg
- Girls Kumite: -40kg, -45kg, +45kg
- **Duration**: Elimination: 90s. Final: 90s > 90s.
- o Kata: Round 1 (Yantsu), Final (Gekisai Sono San).

#### • 14 - 15 Years Old

- Boys Kumite: -55kg, -60kg, -65kg, +65kg
- o **Girls Kumite**: -50kg, -55kg, +55kg
- **Duration**: Elimination: 90s > 90s. Final: 2m > 2m.
- Kata: Round 1 (Tsuki No Kata), Final (Gekisai Sono San).

#### 16 - 17 Years Old

- Boys Kumite: -55kg, -65kg, -75kg, +75kg
- Girls Kumite: -55kg, -65kg, +65kg
- **Duration**: Elimination: 2m > 2m. Final: 2m > 2m.
- o Kata: Round 1 (Gekisai Sono San), Final (Bassai).

#### Men & Women (+18)

- Men's Kumite: -70kg, -80kg, -90kg, +90kg
- O Women's Kumite: -55kg, -65kg, +65kg
- **Duration**: Elimination: 2m > 2m. Final: 3m > 2m > 2m > weight > 2m.
- o Kata: Round 1 (Bassai), Final (Kanku).

#### Seniors / Veterans

- Senior Men (+40): -85kg, +85kg
- Senior Women (+35): -65kg, +65kg
- **Duration**: Elimination: 90s > 90s. Final: 90s > 90s.
- o Kata: Round 1 (Saifa), Final (Seienchin).
