Only competitors with registered BC or DOP will be able to access the competition area.

Attire: White dress shirts with collar and dark long pants (grey, black, or dark blue).

Registered coach only. Only one coach at the time on tatami.

Please double check the provided body weight of your competitors during on-line registration.

Discrepancies in weight and age may result in disqualification. No age group or weight changes are allowed on site registration.

COMPETITORS:

All competitors need the ID Card, IKO Membership Card, medical certificate not older than 1 year, waiver form, clean, white kyokushin karate-dogi and complete set of obligatory **white** protectors required for a chosen category.

AWARDING CEREMONY:

During the awarding ceremony all medalists should wear Karate Dogi. No national flags allowed during the awarding ceremony.

JUDGE/REFEREE:

Each Dojo is cordially invited to bring at least one certified judge or referee.

The tournament will be held individually in a Cup's System. One category may be combined with another one by the decision of Main Referee if there are less than three competitors. Competitors of all age categories will be fighting according to world-wide IKO regulations. In categories with only 4 competitors, there will be a fight for 3rd place. Competitor is required to be ready to fight after call out in no longer than 1 minute time in full set of protectors. The Administrator do not provide obligatory protectors.

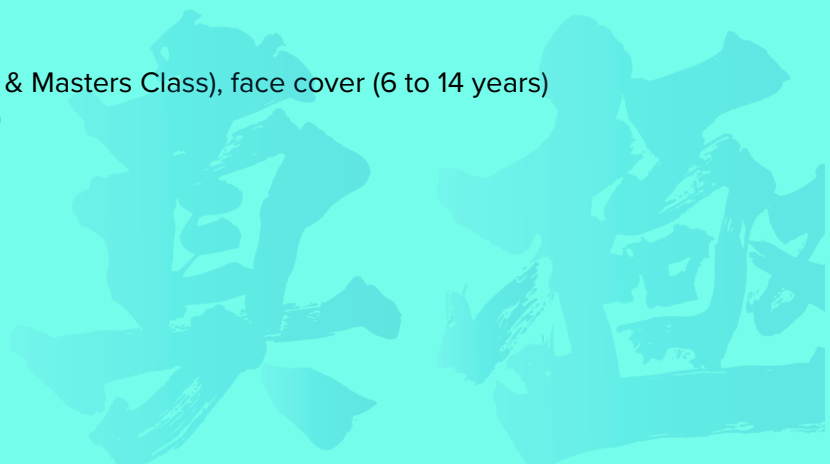
PROTECTIVE GEAR

Obligatory IKO Style:

- White fist protection (all under 18 years & Masters Class)
- White shin & instep protection (all under 18 years & Masters Class)
- Groin protection (male and female)
- Soft knee protection
- Breast protection (girls and women)
- White Head protection (all under 18 & Masters Class), face cover (6 to 14 years)
- White Body protection (all under 15)

Optional:

- Mouth piece

- The organizer and those entrusted with the organization assume no liability for any damage or injury resulting from this event. Participation in the competitions is at your own risk.
- It is recommended that you take out appropriate insurance.
- All participants (especially athletes, coaches, trainers and officials) are obliged to strictly follow the instructions of the organizing committee and the referees.
- By participating, participants agree to the publication of their picture on the Internet on the homepage of the organizer and IKO Austria (Kyokushin Austria).
- The Austrian Anti-Doping Law applies!

SECOND RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Attire:

White dress shirts with collar and dark long pants (grey, black, or dark blue).
*Bare feet, sandals and high heels are prohibited.

2. Behavior and language:

As a Kyokushin Karate second, you must behave properly with respect.

*Prohibited:

- (1) Physical contact with a competitor during a match
- (2) Stand up or leave the designated seat (second's chair) while the competitor is on the mat (Tatami)
- (3) Insults, slander and aggression towards any competitor, or towards any person or entity associated with, or attending the Championships
- (4) Complaints, or counter claims to the judge, or of the decision of the Officials
- (5) Disregarding the direction or order of the judge, or of any Championship staff

If a second does not adhere to the above rules, Championships Officiating Committee will give the second a warning at the first offense. A subsequent offense will result in immediate ejection from the Championships and indefinite suspension.
